Questions No. 27 to 32

Today, we're going to focus on art in the digital age. With advances in technology, how people view art is changing. In recent years, some art collections have been put online to create "digital art museums." Why are art museums moving to digital spaces?

One reason has to do with visitor access. In digital museums, visitors can experience art without the limitation of physical spaces. If museums are online, more people can make virtual visits to them. Also, as online museums never close, visitors can stay for as long as they like! Another reason is related to how collections are displayed. Online exhibits enable visitors to watch videos, see the artwork from various angles, and use interactive features. This gives visitors much more specific information about each collection.

Putting collections online takes extra effort, time, and money. First, museum directors must be eager to try this new format. Then, they have to take the time to hire specialists and raise the money to buy the necessary technology. Of course, many people might still want to see the actual pieces themselves. These factors are some reasons why not all museums are adding an online format.

Many art museums have been offering digital versions of their museums for free, but this system might change in the future. Museums will probably need to depend on income from a hybrid style of both in-person and online visitors.
